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# ABOUT THE SCIENCE FACULTY

The Science Faculty comprises of six specialist science teachers and one Science Technician. The team includes an Early Career Teacher (ECT) alongside colleagues on the Upper Pay Scale who bring significant experience and a strong understanding of the school.

The faculty is committed to continual improvement, with professional development central to its work. Faculty-led CPD sessions take place regularly within school, and the department is actively involved in Lancashire subject network meetings and the local teaching school alliance.

The faculty benefits from excellent facilities, including four well-equipped laboratories a dedicated STEM room, and a preparation room. Further investment is planned, with work due to begin on the creation of a fifth science laboratory during the summer term.

The Science Faculty is reflective and forward-thinking in its approach to curriculum design. We currently deliver the Ark Science curriculum; however, from September 2026 we will transition to White Rose Science. This change will support a more consistent pedagogical approach aligned with the Mathematics Department and will build on the mathematical methods and skills students develop in primary school, which follow the same approach.

At Key Stage 4, students study AQA Combined Science, with the option to pursue Separate Sciences. One class per year currently follows the Separate Science route. In addition, some Key Stage 4 students study NCFE Engineering.
