# ABOUT THE ARTS, PERFORMANCE AND TECHNOLOGIES FACULTY

The Arts, Performance and Technologies (APT) Faculty is an ambitious and forward-thinking faculty comprising "Open Bucket" subjects, including Art, Physical Education, Drama, Music, Business, Computing, Design Technology and 3D Design. The faculty is staffed by ten full-time teachers and one part-time teacher.

Within the PE department, the team consists of one male PE teacher, one female PE teacher (for which this post is advertised), and two additional members of staff who support PE delivery alongside their cover supervisor roles. Faculty resources are excellent, and the department benefits from a dedicated sports block comprising a sports hall, dance studio and teaching classroom. In addition, the department makes regular use of the school yard, MUGA and has access to Moor Park, located adjacent to the sports block, for activities including athletics, football and orienteering. The department is well equipped with a wide range of sport-specific resources.

Students enjoy their PE lessons, and we are proud of the progress we have made in encouraging all students to engage actively, regardless of ability or prior experience. PE is taught in mixed-gender groups, and at Key Stage 3, students receive four lessons per fortnight delivered by a specialist teacher. The curriculum enables students to develop knowledge and skills across a broad range of sports, with ME skills embedded throughout, underpinning the rationale for curriculum design.

At Key Stage 4, all students receive three lessons per fortnight of core PE taught by a specialist teacher. Students also have the option to study GCSE Physical Education (OCR), and numbers for the upcoming Year 10 cohort is strong.

The department offers a wide range of engaging extracurricular opportunities across a variety of sports. Sports teams have flourished in recent years, achieving notable successes including Preston District Table Tennis Champions and League 2 Basketball winners, while consistently competing across all sports. Members of the PE department lead lunchtime activities, after-school practices and drive the minibus to support participation in sporting fixtures and events.

Our staff are passionate, collaborative, committed and reflective practitioners, and the faculty is driven by a strong belief that all pupils can and will achieve.
